Camping together means that our young people can get to know other Christians from their local area and we can provide resources for churches with limited resources.

This is a Christian Festival aimed at helping 13-18 year olds explore what it means to live out a Christian Faith and make a difference in the world, through seminars, worship and activities at the East of England Arena, Peterborough.
