Fire	Minor injuries whilst cooking and major injuries if tents catch fire	<ul> <li>Fire extinguishers in place</li> <li>Bucket of water by each cooking point for first aid and extinguishing</li> <li>Fire warning alarm accessible to team</li> <li>Sockets and equipment turned off when not required</li> <li>Gas connections on cookers checked and matches kept safe</li> <li>No smoking allowed in tents</li> <li>Team and young people reminded of fire evacuation process</li> </ul>		High	Leaders and young people
Slips, trips and bumps	Young people and leaders may be injured if they trip over objects or slip on spillages.	<ul> <li>Clear pathways between tents to access communal areas</li> <li>No guy ropes/pegs around cooking areas</li> <li>Problematic guy ropes and pegs to be marked</li> <li>Any spillage to be marked by a chair and cleared up immediately</li> <li>Care to be taken whilst erecting tents and banging in pegs. Arrival time planned that this does not happen in the dark</li> </ul>	Medium	Medium	Leaders and young people

Security	Young person absconds or is kidnapped Valuable items go missing	<ul> <li>Onsite security managed by Satellites team</li> <li>All young people to sign code of conduct agreeing not to leave the site without leader's permission which will only be given in exceptional circumstances</li> <li>All leaders to be DBS checked and safely recruited</li> <li>Young people to agree to meal and bed times and respond to phone calls if not present then</li> <li>Young people reminded to keep themselves safe</li> <li>Frequent reminders of pastoral support available so that issues can be dealt with rather than precipitate running away</li> <li>Enough leaders to ensure that if a young person does leave the site without permission there is capacity for two leaders to leave the site and search for them/ deal with police, etc.</li> <li>Young people advised not to bring anything of value with them, and not to leave valuable items in tents when not around</li> </ul>	Low	High	Satellites team Leaders and young people

Games and Play equipment	Fractures, cuts, bruises and any other injuries caused by falling or collision during play	<ul> <li>Team will issue appropriate         instructions for play and games and         supervise constantly</li> <li>First aider and first aid kit available</li> </ul>	Medium	Medium	Leaders Satellites Event Team
Electricity	Team and children may suffer serious and possibly fatal electric shock/burns injuries from faulty electrical equipment or installation.	<ul> <li>May not be any electricity in camping area depending on availability of hook up</li> <li>Young people encouraged to charge phones at charging points on site, not the electric hook up</li> <li>Ensure equipment check and no trailing leads</li> </ul>	Low	High	Leaders and young people
Misuse of chemicals	Possible misuse of cleaning chemicals resulting in burns. Possible inhalation or ingestion of recreational drugs or excessive alcohol resulting in psychosis or overdose	<ul> <li>Cleaning materials to be stored and used appropriately</li> <li>Young people to sign code of conduct agreeing not to use recreational drugs or drink alcohol</li> <li>If drug or alcohol abuse by a young person or leader is suspected then appropriate measures to be taken to ensure that they are safe until sober</li> </ul>	Medium	High	Leaders and young people
Hot Liquids	Scolds and burns could potentially occur	<ul> <li>Care to be taken when preparing and moving around with hot drinks.</li> <li>Cooking surfaces to be made as stable as possible</li> <li>Buckets of cold water near cooking points</li> </ul>	Low	Medium	Leaders and young people

Manual Handling	Incorrect manual handling of camping equipment could result in injury	<ul> <li>Make sure team and young people do not lift heavy objects on their own</li> </ul>	Low	Low	Leaders and young people
Infections	Young people and leaders	<ul> <li>Sickness/ diarrhoea/blood spillages to be cleared up by team over the age of 18 wearing correct protective equipment and using the correct cleaning liquids.</li> <li>Leaders and young people advised to stay in their tent if feeling unwell. This may require anyone sharing to move</li> <li>Hand sanitiser readily available</li> </ul>	Madium	Medium	All team
